The Women's Masters community, the hockey family at Manning Valley and her family and friends have been deeply saddened by the recent passing of Di Cubbin.

At the celebration of her life, Di was described as: "...a loving wife and adoring mother; a tireless worker; a smart and focused administrator; a tough, uncompromising, talented player; the life of the party with a great dry sense of humour; a person of unwavering support and love and dear friend."

Many Women's Masters players would be aware of the huge amount of administrative work that Di performed in running the Women's Masters Championships at Taree. She made a massive contribution to Manning Valley hockey both at Club and Association level and was a NSW Women's Masters player for six years and member of Women's Masters Committee. Qualities of strength, courage, tenacity and determination were very much in evidence both on and off the field and in the last few years as she faced a battle with her illness.

## South - Moorebank

We ask that every team try to bring suitable umpires for their commitments and not overload Moorebank's resources. Liaison to access umpires from Moorebank's umpires pool will be done through Sue and payment (\$25 per umpire per game) made directly to Sue (not the Women's Masters Committee), no later than the Managers/umpires meetings on the first day of play.

#### North - Taree

The tent provider for Taree is R & B Marguee Providers (02) 6552 3786.

Associations should liaise with this provider if they need a tent. Taree will indicate where Association tents can be set up. Other provider is Hire Port - (02) 6583 1015.

Payment of \$25 per umpire per game will be made directly to the Umpires' Coordinator prior to the Managers/Umpires meetings on the first day of play.
