CLEARANCES

Clearances are NOT required for Women's Masters.

Women's Masters State Championships operate autonomously and therefore are not governed by the Representative Hockey Policy launched by Hockey NSW in 2015.

The Women's Masters State Championships is one of mateship, fraternity and having fun with friends playing hockey together. Clearances were used in the past - 15-20 years ago - to make sure an Unfinancial player didn't play with another Association. Hockey NSW can now track Unfinancial players using the STG system (whether a Master or otherwise).
